

Travel Documents: Electronic Tickets

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Updated 5th March 2020

Airlines are no longer issuing conventional paper tickets.

Your forthcoming flights will be with an **electronic ticket** and therefore **no paper tickets** (with coupons containing the exact flight information) are enclosed. With an electronic ticket your booking information is held within the airline's reservation system, and is indicated as electronic tickets when you check in.

Please take a copy of your confirmation and/or reservation number to the appropriate flight check-in desk on your date of travel at least **1½ hours** prior to your scheduled time of departure. Check in opens 2 hours prior to departure and closes 30 minutes prior to departure time.

On **proof of identification** (either your passport or other form of photographic ID), you will be issued with your boarding pass. The same procedure will apply for your return travel.

Baggage allowances vary between carriers and are listed below, one piece of hold luggage per person excluding infants:

British Airways	BA	23kg plus 10kg cabin baggage within size limit 56cm x 45cm x 25cm
easyJet	EZ	23kg plus 1 piece cabin baggage within size limit 56cm x 45cm x 25cm
Blue Islands	SI	23kg plus 10kg cabin baggage within size limit 55cm x 35cm x 20cm
Aurigny	GR	20kg plus 6-10kg cabin baggage depending on route within size limit 55cm x 36cm x 20cm
Loganair	LM	20kg plus 1 piece cabin baggage within size limit 40cm x 35cm x 18cm
Aer Lingus	EI	20kg plus 1 piece cabin baggage within size limit 55cm x 40cm x 24cm
